

- VHSL Information
 - Test Should be Open as of Today
 - Clinic will be online
 - (Target Release Date is August 1st.)
 - Completion of test and clinic required by August 22nd
 - Implicit Bias course Required as well.
 - Late Fees
 - A \$50 late fee will be assessed for officials that do not view or attend (noted sports) the clinic by the deadline for their particular sport.
 - A \$50 late fee will be assessed for officials that do not take the rules test by the deadline for their particular sport.

Commissioner's Report -

Eligibility Levels:

• Level 3:

- Officials may officiate regular season Varsity and sub-varsity contests and post season, if selected.
- Level 3 officials must have scored an 85% or above on the rules exam, viewed the rules clinic in its entirety, completed the Implicit Bias course and be in good standing with their local association.

• Level 2:

- Officials may officiate regular season Varsity and sub-varsity contests but are not eligible for post-season play.
- Level 2 officials must have scored between 75-84% on their rules exam, viewed the rules clinic in its entirety, completed the Implicit Bias course and be in good standing with their local association.

• Level 1:

- Officials may officiate sub-varsity contests only.
- Level 1 officials must have scored a 70-74% on their rules exam, viewed the rules clinic in its entirety, completed the Implicit Bias course and be in good standing with their local association.
- State Event Pass
- NEW FOR 2022: We will be sending each association a State Championship Officials Pass for their officials that are Level 3 certified (free of charge).
- This pass will get your officials into state championship games.
- The VHSL Office will send them out October for Fall sports.
- A regular State Event Pass is still available for purchase for anyone that is not a Level 3 certified official.
